

Mergers Alliance H1 2021 Highlights

Exceptional performance compared to it's competitors in the market

- In H1 2021 Mergers Alliance completed 37 M&A deals worldwide for USD 1.43 billion. In Europe, we advised on 27 transactions valued at USD 1.2 billion.
- 30% of Mergers Alliance transactions were crossborder.
- Average deal value in H1 2021 was USD 42 million.
- The mid-market remains Mergers Alliance's core focus. Most deals were in the value range of USD10 million to USD 100 million. 2 deals over USD 200 were closed during this period.
- Deal activity in Mergers Alliance reflects that TMT and Business Services sectors are the most active with respectively 10 and 8 closed transactions.
- The largest transactions in terms of deal value were completed within Industrials (Chemicals) and Business Services (Management Consultancy)

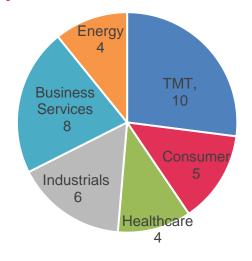

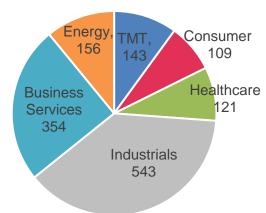

H1 2021 deals by sector



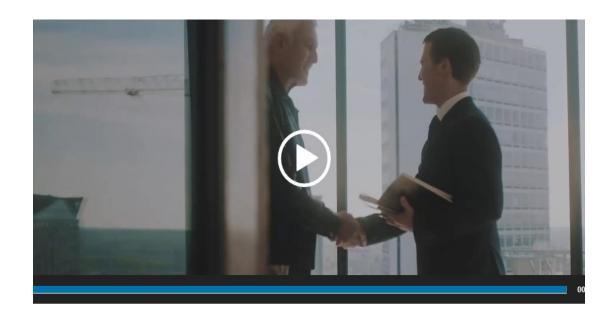

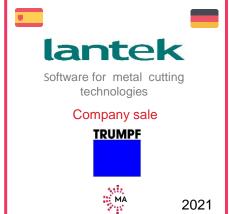

Opus Corporate Finance advised outstanding mega deal within the Chemicals space

Advised by Opus, Bain Capital and Cinven entered into definitive agreements to acquire Lonza Specialty Ingredients, a division of Lonza AG, for a total enterprise value of USD 4.7 billion.

Given LSI will be a platform asset for an M&A led growth strategy, Opus helped their client to map the opportunity through research and the utilization of their global network in the chemical space. Opus were then able to provide advice on exit valuation, thereby generating client conviction around entry valuation and their willingness to pre-empt the closing stages of a highly competitive auction process.

The transaction is expected to close in H2 2021, subject to customary closing conditions.
